

On the Table Philly Activate Mini Grants Application

Participants in this year's **On the Table Philly** can apply for Activate mini grants in amounts up to \$1,000 to fund fresh, innovative ideas generated during their Nov. 8 **On the Table Philly** conversations about ways to make the Greater Philadelphia region a better place to live, work and play.

A total of \$50,000 will be awarded through The Philadelphia Foundation. Additional ideas not ideas not selected for funding will be shared with the wider community for possible additional support.

The extended Application deadline is **Mon., Nov. 26, at 5 p.m.** Recipients will be notified in December. Projects must be completed no later than June 30, 2019. Only one submission per applicant will be accepted.

- Participate in one or more **On the Table** conversations (You must be registered as an **On the Table Philly** 2018 host or have signed in as a guest at a table on Nov. 8 to apply.)
- Create a short video (no longer than 90 seconds) explaining your idea, how it works and its potential impact - these videos can be shot quickly with your phone, no need to be highly produced.
- Submit this application to OnTheTablePhilly@LISC.org with the link to your video by **Mon., Nov. 26 at 5 p.m.**
